### Prep Transition Program!

Dear Parent/Carer,

We have recently been given access to a datasytem called Early Years Evaluation. This tool is being used by several schools in our network. It enables schools to gather information about individual students that they can use for future planning. This tool will enable us to best meet your child's need.

You will be contacted to make an appointment with Carrie Wilson (Prep Teacher) for your child to work through the interactive activities. These appointments will be on Mondays between 8:45am and 11am for the remainder of Term 4, or during the day on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup> or 28<sup>th</sup> of November.

We have slightly modified our Prep Transition organisation to enable us to provide parents with pertinent information about the learning opportunities at our school and also changes that will come into effect during 2018. Parents/carers can attend these sessions while their children are taking part in transition. Please see below for the amended days and times for each transition visit.
